UNDER a sparkling chandelier, art is on the menu at a Neutral Bay gallery.

Traffic Jam Galleries at Neutral Bay runs regular Artist Dinners hosted by an artist and featuring a gourmet menu from chef Brett Deverall.

The next dinner on October 17 will feature Sculpture by the Sea artist Hugh McLachlan.

The select group at the event get to view his latest work and hear how he approaches his art practice.

A respected sculptor, McLachlan will exhibit paintings for the first time at the dinner.

His work has been selected for

Sculpture by the Sea at Bondi and Cottesloe in 2011, 2013 and 2014. It is characterised by highly polished steel surfaces that appear like liquid flowing off clifftops.

McLachlan's sculpture has its genesis in his jewellery designs and his training as a gold and silversmith.

The gourmet menu for the dinner is prepared by Brett Deverall, head of the Sydney Cooking School at Neutral Bay.

Traffic Jam Galleries is located on the residential island bounded by Military Rd and Falcon St and is also currently showing the work of artists Rebecca Pierce and Nicholas Daunt.
