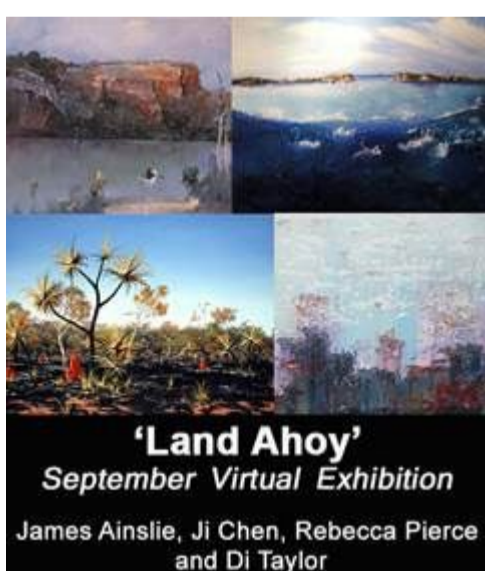
Cezary Stulgis
