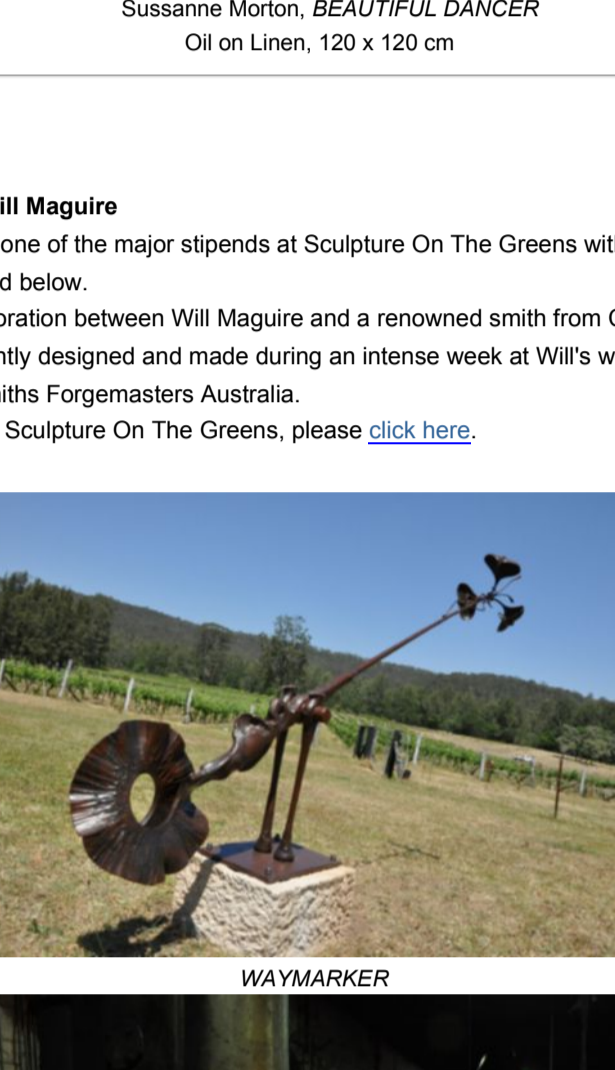

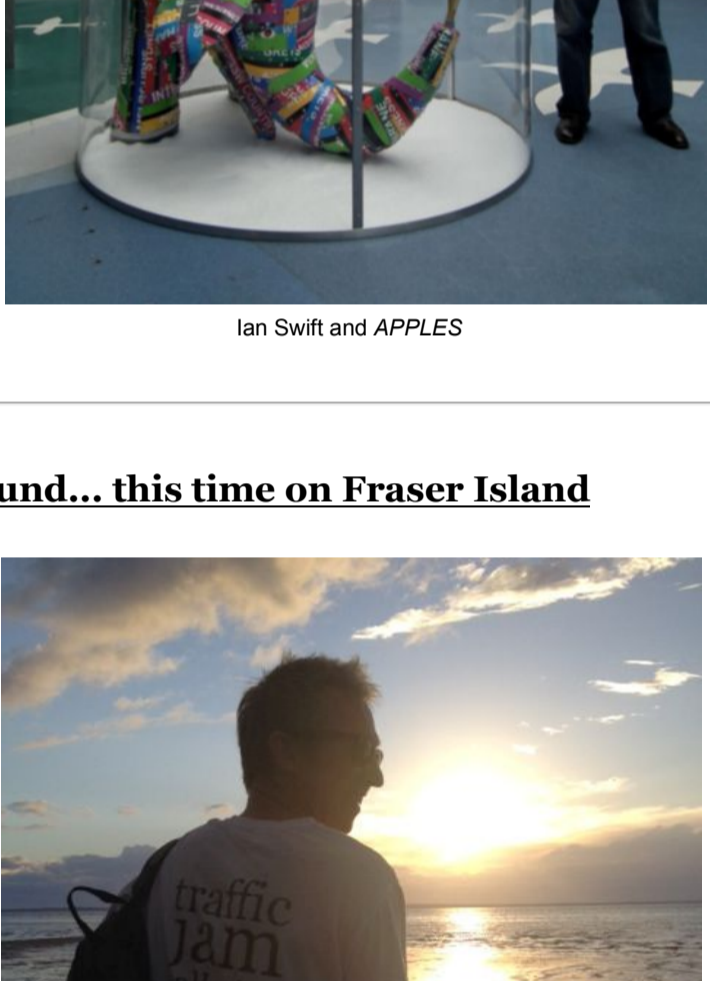

Congratulations to Will Maguire

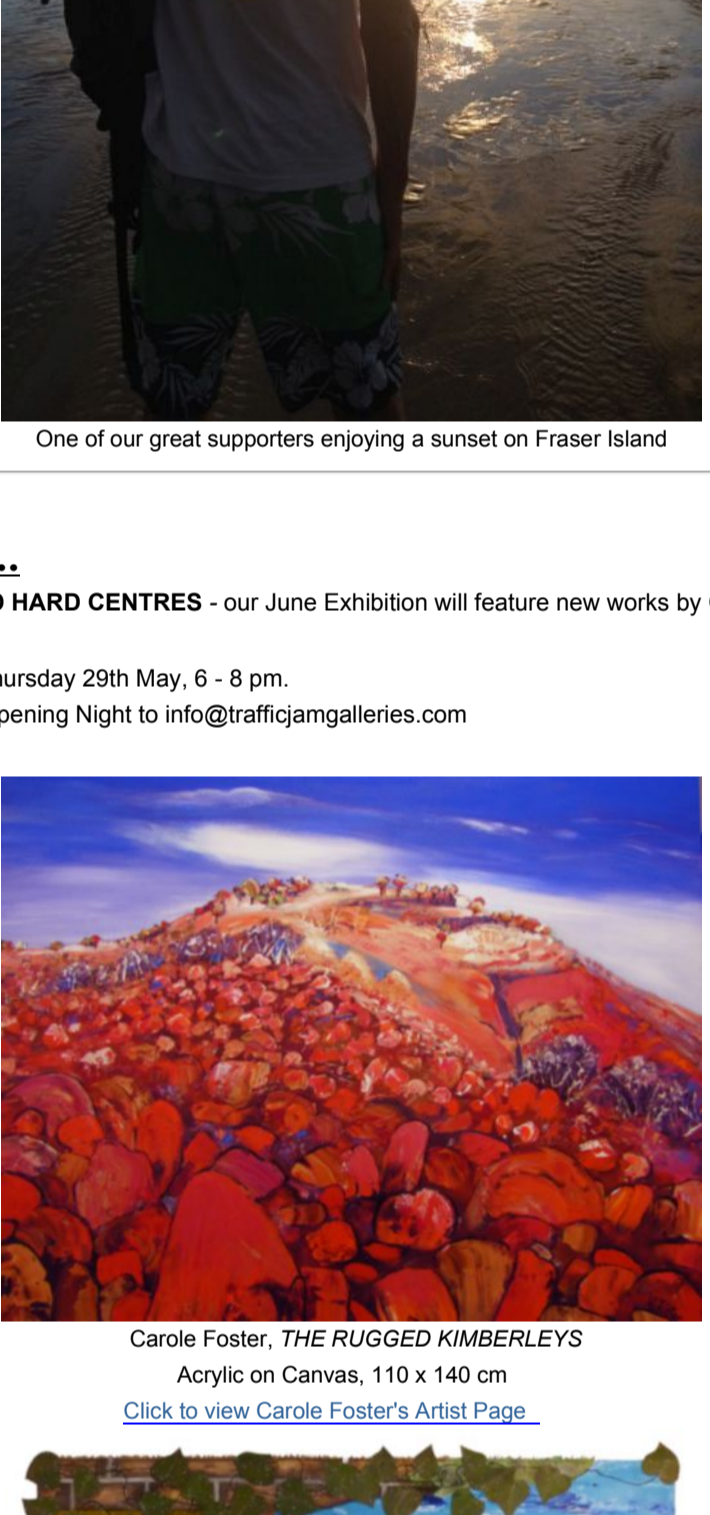
Will Maguire has won one of the major stipends at Sculpture On The Greens with the sculpture *WAYMARKER*, pictured below.

Fondly known by the tjg team as 'Apples', *EXTREME SURFING* was briefly with us until Ian found out this amazing work constructed of steel, plastic, fibreglass and found objects, had made Sculpture by the Sea, Bondi 2011. This was then the eighth time that Ian's work had been selected for this prestigious event and Ian also featured in 2012 in the ephemeral division of the competition.

'Apples' created such a sensation in the gallery and when the giant elephant (which measures 220(h) x 155 x 160 cm) was secured in one of the windows, the response was hard to keep up with, with phone enquiries and passers-by coming in to give a friendly pat.

EXTREME SURFING was purchased from Ian this year by a collector who donated it to The Children's Hospital at Westmead, where it now forms part of their collection and is on permanent display.

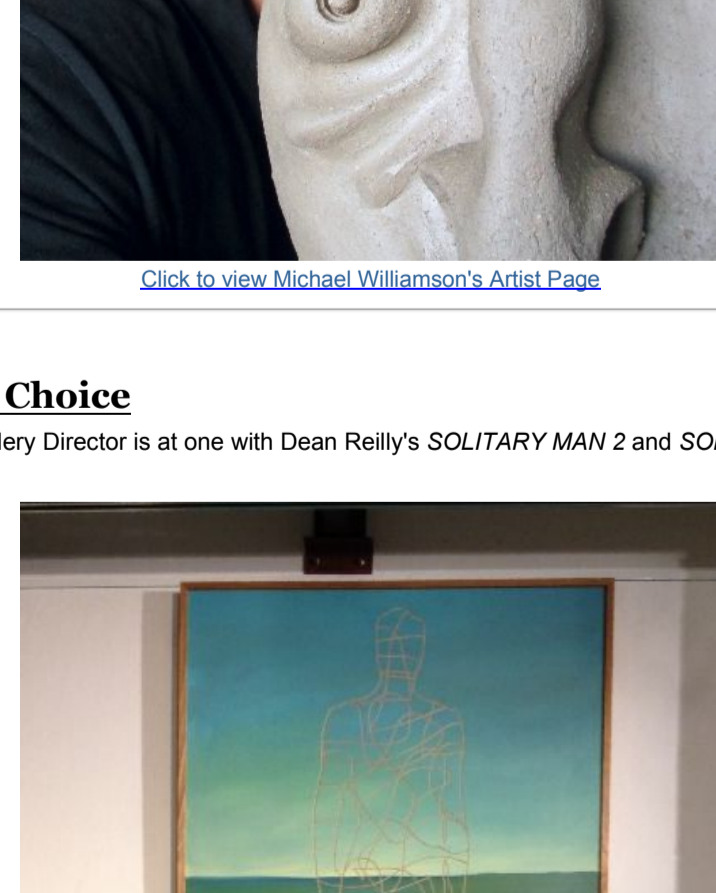

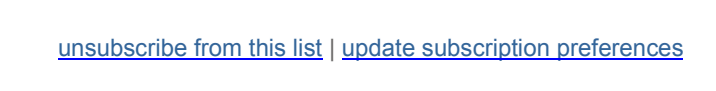
