

Jenny Green at the Venice Biennale - Part 2

tjg Artist **Jenny Green** has recently returned from an overseas trip, and was lucky enough to spend some time at the Venice Biennale. Below is her second short installment about the exhibition, and her thoughts about the Japanese pavilion and its contents:

"Walking into Japan's pavilion at this year's Venice Biennale is a sensory delight - an explosion of vivid red thread, and thousands of tarnished old keys hanging off this thread, showering over two wooden boats. Chiharu Shiota's installation, 'The Key In The Hand' reflects on memory. In daily life, keys protect valuable things such as our houses, assets, and personal safety. Over years, these thousands of old keys picked up countless, multi-layered memories. This is a 'simple' work, astonishingly executed, and extraordinary meditative."

The 56th Venice Biennale runs until 22 November 2015 and features exhibitions from 89 countries, 136 artists and 44 collateral events.




